

OASA Canadians Payment and Pick Up Policy

Purpose:

To outline the funds to be paid by teams to the OASA that qualify to represent us at the Softball Canada Championships and the actions to be imposed should they not make the required payment by the established due date.

Softball Canada Tournament Entry Fee \$850.00

U15 to U20 teams qualifying to participate in the Softball Canada Championships are required to pay the following amounts to the OASA to guarantee their place in the tournament.

First Place	\$0	(\$850 to be paid to SC by the OASA)
Second Place	\$250	(\$600 to be paid to SC by the OASA)
Third Place	\$500	(\$350 to be paid to SC by the OASA)
Fourth Place	\$850	(\$0 to be paid to SC by the OASA)

U23 and older teams qualifying to participate in the Softball Canada Championships are each required to pay the full \$850 entry fee to the OASA to guarantee their place in the tournament.

Payment can be made by e-transfer to OASA Treasurer (oasa1923@outlook.com) – preferred method, or by cheque payable to the OASA by the Wednesday following the conclusion of the OASA Elimination Tournament.

The following is an excerpt from OR 7.2 f) in the 2026 Official By-Laws and Operating Rules:

f) Player Selections (Pick-Ups)

i) Teams qualifying for a Canadian Championship are allowed to add to their roster a maximum of three (3) players provided they have space on their roster. A player does not have to play in the Elimination Tournament to be eligible for pick-up, but must be registered on an Ontario certificate. The winning team will select their first player; followed by the other teams in order of qualifying finish. Once all teams have made their first player selection, the second round begins with the first place team selecting their second player. The third round begins with the first place team selecting their third player. Each player selection should be made within a 24 hour period. Once all teams have made their three (3) selections, the names will be submitted to the Registrar for completion of the Softball Canada rosters.

The pickup process will start no later than the Wednesday after the OASA Elimination tournament. If all the Softball Canada Tournament Entry Fees have been received the pickup process will begin immediately. As of the Wednesday following the tournament, if the Softball Canada Tournament Entry Fee has not been received or proof of cheque in mail (picture of cheque emailed to the Treasurer) the team will be skipped in the pickup process. Once payment is received the team will join the regular schedule of pickups. The skipped pick(s) will be made at the end of the pickup process.
