

Ontario Amateur Softball Association Membership Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to define who is deemed to be a member of the Ontario Amateur Softball Association (OASA).

2. Definitions

Affiliated Member – Players, coaches and staff of teams that participate in one or more of OASA's U9 Events, Qualifiers, Eliminations or Provincial tournaments after paying the required annual individual fees and register in the OASA Member Registration System (MRS) are considered members.

Associate Member – OASA may accept Associate Member players, coaches and staff upon application by paying a prescribed fee.

Insurance Only Participant – Teams, Leagues and Associations who only obtain insurance coverage through OASA are not considered members.

Executive Members – The current OASA Board of Directors as well as all Past Presidents are considered members.

3. By-Laws

OASA publishes its By-Laws on its website on an annual basis, subject to any amendments received and voted on at its Annual General Meeting. Within those By-Laws are a more fulsome explanation of what conditions exist regarding becoming and staying a member of the OASA.

They cover Membership Categories, Authority, Admission and Renewal, Fees and Duration, Transfer, Suspension and Termination, Good Standing, Meetings, Voting. They can be viewed here:
