SKILLS EVENT

1. FLY BALL CHALLENGE

- How many fly balls get caught before 5 drops.

2. BASE RUNNING RELAY

- Players run the bases with a baton, and hand off at home every time to the player. Winning time will be an average calculation in the event there is 3, 4 or 5 kids per team.

3. THROWING RELAY

- 40 feet away. Players throw to each other and follow their throw to the other line. Points are calculated by how many consecutive throws are made and caught.
- 3 drops

Each event needs a minimum of 3 participants from a team. Players are only allowed to participate in 1 event.

Total scoring for 8 teams so 8 points for 1st, 7 points for 2nd, 6 points for 3rd and so on for each event.
